


Chapter 1: What is Economics

 8. Division of a complex procedure into small tasks, enabling workers to increase output through specialization.
 9. Study of how society chooses to use scarce resources to satisfy its unlimited wants & needs.
 10. Someone who studies economic theory and applies it to the real world.
 11. The production of goods & services using the smallest amounts of resources for the greatest amount of output.
 12. Someone who undertakes and develops a new business enterprise or develops a new product
 13. A resource used to produce goods & services.
 14. Objects or materials that can be purchased to satisfy human wants or needs
 15. Study of an entire economy or one of its principal sectors.
 16. Study of a single factor of an economy - such as individuals, households, businesses, & industries - rather than an economy as a whole.

 18. Value lost by rejecting one use of resources in favor of another. In other words, the value of the next-best alternative action that is not taken.
